# Jefferson County Missouri Schools Analysis

This analysis shows the location and district number of each of the county schools. They are listed in the following format. Name of Schoolhouse, School District # after 1910; District and Township # before 1910 compiled from a 1906 list found in the history archives; Township, Range, and Section where known, the property owner where the school was located in the 1876 & 1898 Historical Atlas, the date of the atlas, and notes.

Following the analysis, is a map showing the numbered location of each school, researched and compiled by Becky Gagnon, Lisa K. Gendron, Betty Olson, Jean O'Brien, and Dave Hallemann 1998. Please note that the district numbers listed below correspond with the *Country Schools* book for sale on our publications page. The book contains further details about each school, sometimes noting teachers, names of students, etc....

\* White school is not shown, however it is located on the Bayer Garden Center Property (1999) I-55 north to Imperial exit, east to Old State Road, north to Bayer's. The School sits next to the road. See *Country Schools, Jefferson County, Mo. 1806-1952* by Della Lang; *Jefferson County Historical Society Publication*.

\*\* Sandy School - I am placing this school here. This is the site of the Sandy Baptist Church during this time period. I know there was a school here in the past and feel confident that this is Sandy School. The church and school are shown on both the 1876 and 1898 plats.

\*\*\* On a current Jefferson County Highway map, (1999) there is a road off Old Antonia Road leading west in T42 R5 Sec 24. This road dead ends in about ½ mile. On the 1898 Standard Atlas this road is shown winding its way around and ending at Seckman School. Therefore Seckman School at one time *may* have been called Cook School.

\*\*\*\*\* In 1898 there is a school shown in this location. However in 1876 there is a *church* shown here. A school is denoted by the symbol of a building on the plats, and a church is the same symbol with a cross attached to the top of the building. This could simply have been an error on the cartographers part, or the school shared the church at the time. By 1898 the church *could* have moved to another location and the school board bought the property. There could be many possible explanations for this.


